





Stay_oSafe Attention: Flag Warning System There are dangerous currents at this beach, and fatalities have occurred. Red = Stop.Stay on the beach and out of the water. Yellow = Caution. Watch for dangerous currents and high waves. Green = Go.But stay aware of changing conditions. A red flag means that there is a high risk of drowning. Swimmers: Stay away from piers and other structures. ■ Even an Olympic swimmer couldn't win a race with a dangerous current. Absence of flags does not assure safe waters.

Always pay attention to beach flags and know their meaning!


